

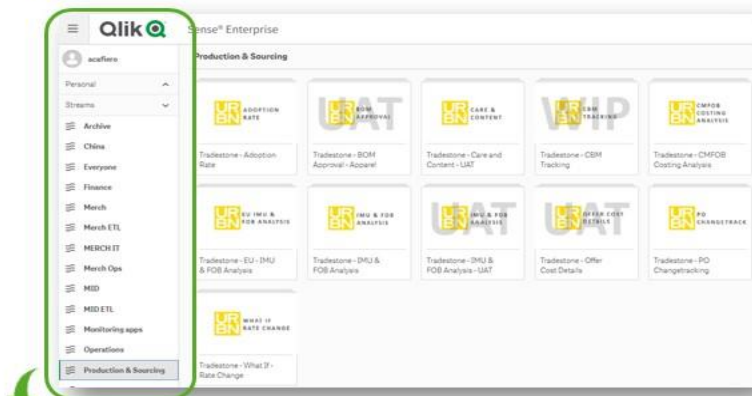


# Did you know...

## These navigational tips in Qlik?



The Hub is the home of all Qlik apps, which are organized in Streams...



Streams are used to organize apps by department, system, or purpose

For example, Production & Sourcing will have all apps used by Production users

Apps may be labeled WIP or UAT

WIP – apps in development, data is not updated unless noted

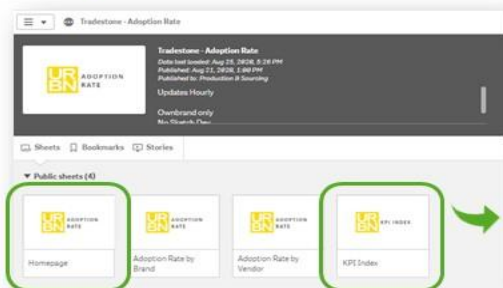
UAT – apps in user testing, data is updated regularly



Clicking on the info button displays app info including; update cadence, backend criteria, and last refresh time



To open an app select the icon, or hit the Open button on the app info...



Apps with a Homepage include the following; last update time, app tutorial, and modification log



Users will either land on a homepage or a landing page, pictured on the left

The landing page shows the screens available in each application

Screens are different compilations of visuals and tables



App screen layouts can differ, but organization is consistent...
